The Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home

Visiting (MIECHV) Program is a parenting program that uses evidence-based models to improve the health and development of children. Enrollment in the program is open to parents and caregivers of babies (up to 12 months) whose lives are impacted by these situations:

- Low-income
- Teen parent
- Low educational attainment
- Child abuse or neglect
- Substance abuse
- Tobacco use in the home
- Children with developmental delays, disabilities or chronic health issues
- Military family

REFER PARENTS who fall into one or more of these categories to MIECHV so they may receive:

- Free parenting support
- Education about child development
- Developmental screenings
- Resources to strengthen their families

REFER PARENTS to MIECHV and you will benefit because:

- We help parents follow their provider's advice and meet appointments
- We connect families to resources that fit their needs
